

Operational Assembly: Kurian Tharakunnel provided these highlights from the February Operational Assembly. The number of Adult Education students has increased this semester necessitating the hiring of nineteen new ESL teachers. Several Financial Aid workshops are offered this semester, and an Open Education Resources (OER) workshop for faculty is scheduled February 23. A Wellness Fair will be held April 12. The Executive Team is currently reviewing FY 24 budget documents and feedback will be ready in March. Ellucian training was completed in January and Ellucian Self-Service implementation is ongoing. The IPEDS research survey has been completed.

Academic Senate: Michael Flaherty provided this update from Senate. Academic & Scholastic Standards is reviewing syllabi requirements. Academic Support continues to work on the late registration policy and Professional Development is updating the classroom observation form. Online Education & Technology presented their work on hybrid courses and online education and Academic Senate has sent a recommendation to VP Campos. Because of Spring Break, the next Academic Senate meeting will be held on March 21.

Student Success: Christina Bavone, Learning Specialist, provided an overview of the Title V grant and corequisite education, showing corequisite course enrollment, withdrawal rates, and course success rates. Next steps are to institutionalize Title V work by providing training to faculty, keeping academic support embedded in curriculum, and continuing to measure metrics and data.

Employment Opportunity Software Upgrades: Joe Klinger presented the upgrades made to Triton's applicant tracking system. PeopleAdmin has been upgraded to the 7.0 version with is more user friendly and allows applicants to gather information about the college. Another feature is that hiring managers are notified when there are new applicants for a position.

Triton Wrestling Team: The wrestling team won the District Championship and are going to the National Tournament in March.
