

Triton College Respiratory Care Program - Admission Checklist

This check list serves to help the student keep track of the admission steps for the Respiratory Care Program.

- ___ Attendance at an information session is required.
- ___ Complete a Triton College Application.
- ___ Complete a Respiratory Care Application.
- ___ Forward official high school/college transcripts to Triton College Records Department.
- ___ Take placement exam if needed/then make an appointment with an academic advisor.

Program Prerequisites

Prerequisites listed below must be completed before the start of the program.

- ___ **RHT 101** (Freshman Rhetoric & Composition)
- ___ **MAT 085** (Algebra and Geometry II), or must meet current college Math requirements for completion of MAT 085
- ___ **AHL 120** (Comprehensive Medical Terminology)
- ___ **BIS 136** (Functional Human Anatomy I) or **BIS 240** (Human Anatomy & Physiology I)
- ___ **CHM 110** (Fundamentals of Chemistry) or **CHM 140** (General Chemistry I)

General Education Requirements

Students awaiting admission to the program are strongly encouraged to complete all other general education requirements prior to entering the program which are required for graduation.

**Completion of the Math, Science, and Allied Health courses must not be more than 5 years old. All pre-/co-requisite coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. All test scores must be within the last two years.*

Please note: Completion of prerequisite courses does not guarantee admission to the program. Students are not considered accepted into the program or eligible to register for Respiratory Care courses until they respond to their official program acceptance letter.
