The Triton College Women's Softball Team will be Competing in the 2024 NJCAA Region 4 Division II Quarterfinals Hosted by Triton College

RIVER GROVE, III. – The Triton College softball team will host the 2024 NJCAA Region 4 Division II Quarterfinals, May 4-5, at the Jorndt Athletic Complex in River Grove.

Triton earned the No. 4 seed in the double-elimination tournament. The winner will advance to the final four that will take place May 11-12 at Black Hawk College in Moline to determine the Region 4 champion.

The Trojans (27-11) will open against the No. 13 seed Sauk Valley Community College (17-26), May 4, at 10 a.m. The two teams have not played each other yet during this season.
