

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I become a student in the Adult Education Department?

- Apply to the ESL, GED, or Spanish GED program by clicking on the “Apply Here” button at the top of the Adult Education website:

How do I know if I am eligible?

- Must be an Illinois resident.
- Provide a picture ID with current address.
- Must be at least 16 years old and not enrolled in high school.
 - 16-and 17-year olds will be asked to get a signed High School Withdrawal Form.
- Classes are not intended for individuals on temporary and student visas.

I filled out an application. What is my next step?

After filling out the application you will get an email to:

1. Come to the office and verify your eligibility, and
2. Make a testing appointment.

How much do classes cost?

ESL classes are free.

GED classes are mostly free.

- Advanced GED classes cost \$3/per credit hour.

When do classes start?

Classes start in August, October, January, March & May.

Are ESL and GED classes online or in-person?

All classes are “hyflex”: they meet in-person with an option to attend online.
